- An advanced degree (Master or PhD) in social sciences or related fields.
- Specialized thematic expertise in population dynamics and data (including data on violence
 against women and girls; traditional and new data sources such as geospatial and georeferenced
 data) as well as in national population data systems (including on gender-based violence and
 harmful practices). Experts should also bring knowledge in population and development issues,
 such as demographic dividend, ageing, and low fertility.
- Knowledge of gender equality and the rights of women and girls, including SRHR, gender norms and human rights. Prior experience with gender-responsive evaluations is a plus.
- Previous direct experience working with a range of groups and movements at global and regional levels to tackle underlying drivers of discrimination; and/or with national stakeholders comprising national statistics offices, think tanks and academia.
- Familiarity with the SDGs, the UN system and UN programming at the country level.
- Strong research capacity including rigorous quantitative and qualitative data collection and analysis, including financial analysis.
- Strong English communication and writing skills. Fluency in other UN languages (French, Spanish, Russian or Arabic) is a plus.

The expected consultancy is mostly home-based. Fieldwork might take place if circumstances allow. We especially encourage applicants from the Global South.
