

What is 'Social and Solidarity Economy'?


Well, it depends on who you ask!

Enterprising not-for-profits, cooperatives, and mutual benefit societies (Quebec Social Economy Act).

Definition 2


SSE is an alternative to capitalism and other authoritarian, state-dominated economic systems. In SSE ordinary people play an active role in shaping all of the dimensions of human life: economic, social, cultural, political, and environmental (RIPESS).



What is the Global Social Economy Forum?

GSEF is an international association of local governments and civil society networks engaged in the promotion of the Social and Solidarity Economy (SSE) as a mean to achieve an inclusive and sustainable local development. GSEF promotes various forms of SSE, including social enterprises, cooperatives, foundations, mutuals and self-help groups that put people over profit. GSEF believes that systemic changes start first at the local level based on the partnership between civil society, and the public and private sectors.




